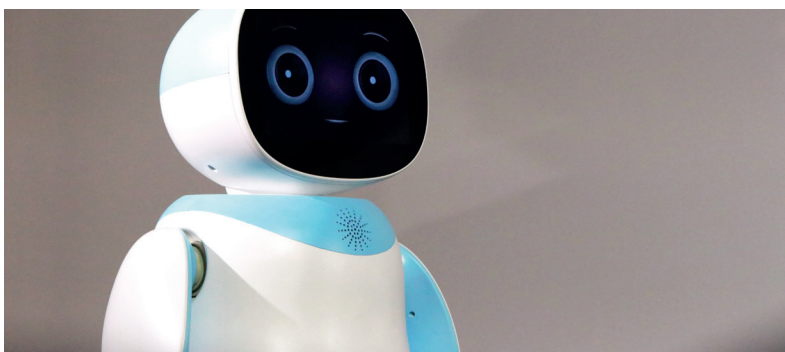


## Case study: China-Britain AI Summit
